Rzeszow University

is organising workshops within the framework of the project "***Development of the didactic potential of Rzeszow University on a European level***".

The major objective of the workshops is the development of the syllabus guidelines for academic subjects taught in English.

We would be delighted if you agreed to become one of five experts invited for the workshops which will take part from **11 to 15 of June 2012**. As an expert you would be expected to prepare and give a 5-hour talk / workshops followed a discussion. We would be grateful if you could prepare a talk/workshops on one of the following topics:

1. Interactive didactic classes;
2. Information in the didactic process;
3. International cooperation in the field of courses run in English;
4. EU funds for financing higher education;
5. Possibilities of improving teachers' didactic qualifications in Europe;

6. Methodology of inspiring students to undertake scientific research;
7. The role of institutions and companies in higher education;
8. Comparability of education in Europe;
9. Methodology of creating interdisciplinary courses;
10. Didactic problems in mixed nationality groups.

If you wish you can also suggest a different topic in line with the general topics of our workshops "New directions in education in Europe" (the topic would have to be accepted by organisers).

A typical day of workshops will be divided into two parts. In the morning, invited experts will present their papers followed by a discussion (each day a different expert). In the afternoon, Rzeszow University teachers divided into pairs will be working directly with assigned experts to create syllabi for academic courses taught in English (so you would have about 1,5 hours every day to assist them

in creating the guidelines for a syllabus).

We can cover the cost of air travel (up to 2000 pln), provide food and accommodation throughout your stay. We should also be able to offer you a symbolic compensation for preparation and delivery of the workshops.

We believe that the workshops will be a great chance for experts from different countries to share knowledge and experience in an international environment.

We are looking for experts from Physical Education, Sport and Tourism&Recreation area.
